



February 2022: Geelong Region | Employment Trend Data

The following information collated from the Geelong Careers website provides a snapshot of current employment trends in the Geelong region over February 2022.

Points of interest:

February job vacancies, though not quite as high as the same time last year, showed a steep increase on jobs advertised over the same period in 2019 and 2020.

Overall February job numbers continued a slight trend down when compared to late last year. It is still too early in 2022 to correlate fluctuating jobs numbers with the new 'living with COVID-19 era' but 2022 could be an interesting year.

This February saw careers in **Building and Construction** head upwards by 34% as tradespeople commenced work post annual holiday break. Also, job advertisements for employment in **Local and State Government** organisations were up by 33%.

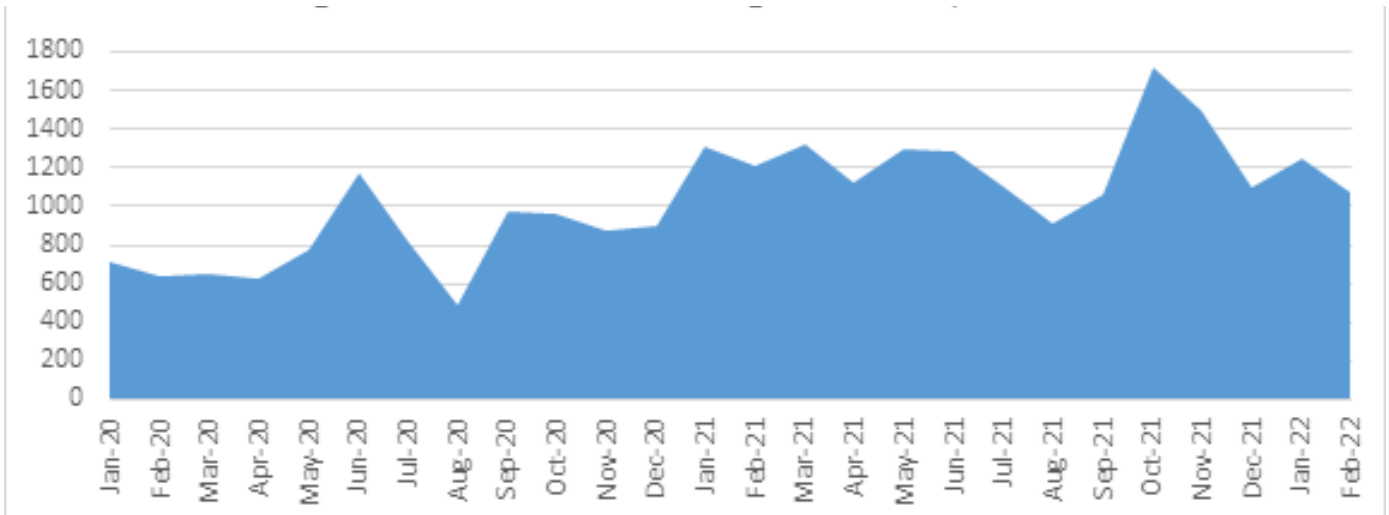
Some sectors continued to trend down in February. These included employment in **Healthcare** (down by 43%), **IT** (down by 33%), **Education** (down by 16%). Careers in **Hospitality** were also down by 30%, however this trend could be expected following the end of the holiday season.

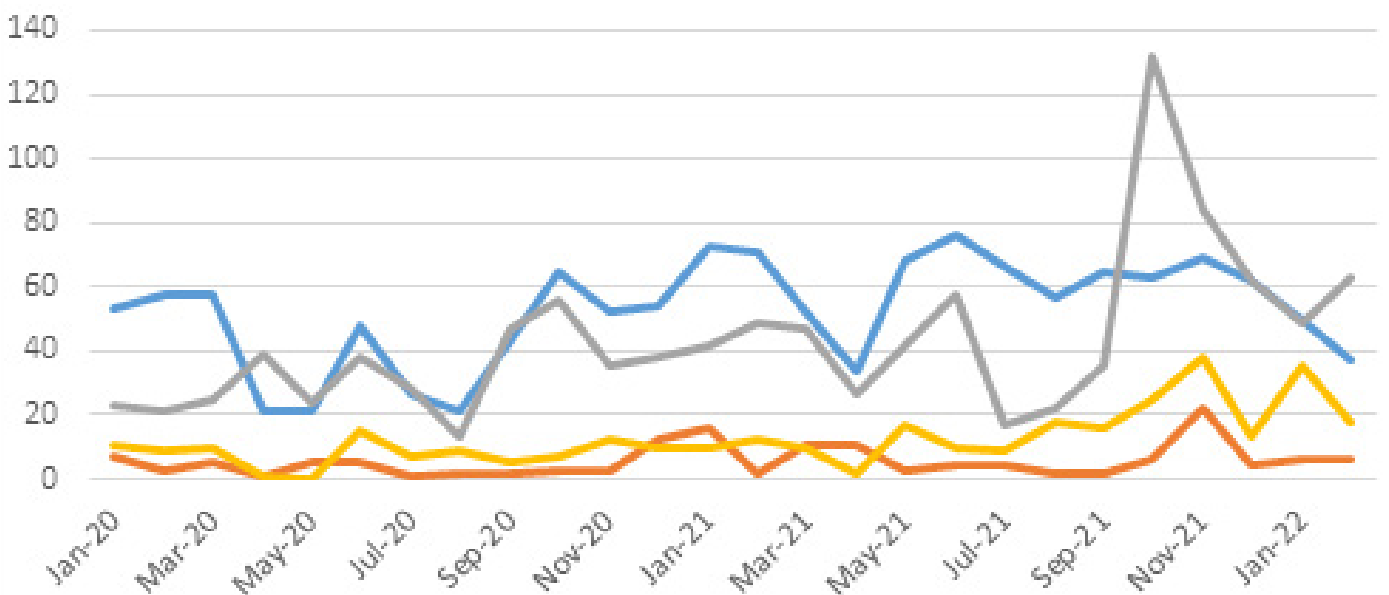




Jobs in G21 region

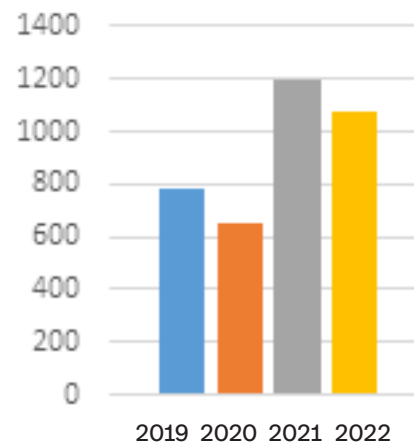

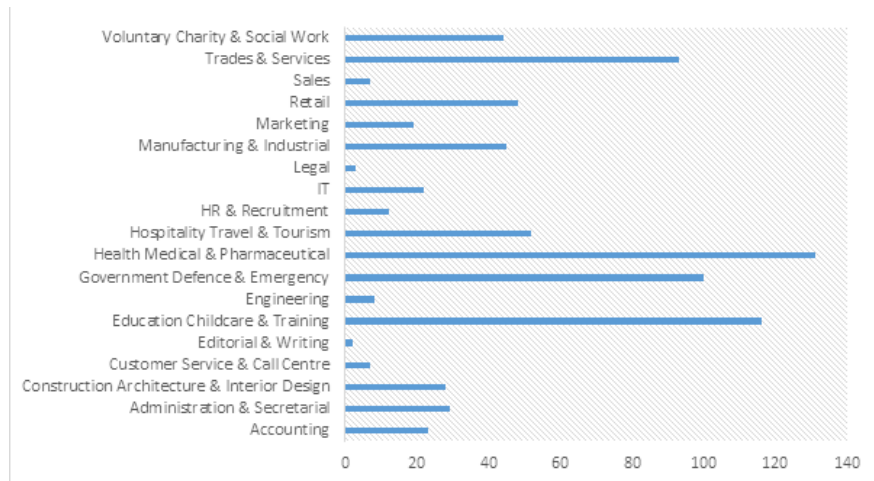
